



Lorenzo Misuri

Education and work experiences

Lorenzo Misuri was born in Arezzo (Italy) in 1997.

At the age of 11 he began his training under the vision of Carolina Basagni and Fabrizio Betti, later he became student of the Accademia Teatro alla Scala in Milan where he graduated in 2016.

After his first working experience at La Scala Ballet Company he joined the Ballet de Catalunya under the direction of Larissa Lezhnina and Elias Garcia Herrera in 2017.

He was soon promoted demi-soloist after dancing leading roles like Picasso in "Picasso's ballerina" by R. Wortmeyer and the Prince in the Nutcracker by E. Herrera.

Lorenzo created for Ballet de Catalunya "Loro in Lei ", Choreography that won the merit award by Europa in Danza, and "Beethoven's Symphony" premiered at Gran Teatre del Liceu, Barcelona.

In 2020 he joined the Croatian National Ballet, Zagreb, where he had the opportunity to dance soloist roles and to choreograph for the company.

Since September 2021 Lorenzo is working at Opera National du Capitole in Toulouse.
